Be sure to include your name—in case we need to contact you.

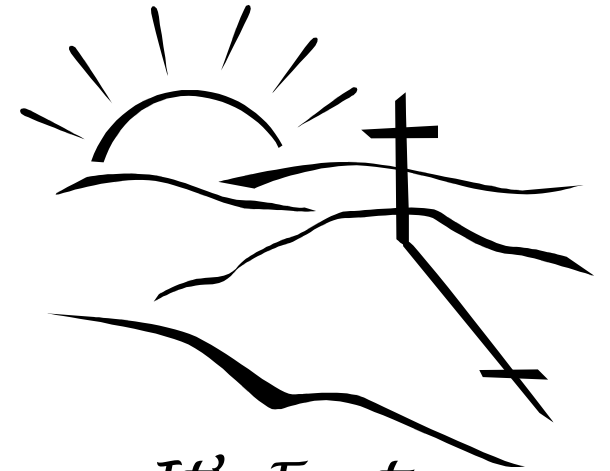
OUR MISSIONS FUNDRAISER
